Hans-Walter-Hennicke Lecture Competition 2025

In remembrance of Prof. Dr. Hans-Walter Hennicke, the DKG has been awarding the Hans-Walter Hennicke Lecture Competition Award since 1995.

With this prize, we honour the best lectures of young ceramists and academics on the topics of their final theses.

Participation is open to all graduates whose Bachelor, Master, Diploma or comparable final examination (no promotion) in the field of raw materials/ceramics at a college, academy or university, does not date back longer than 1.5 years.

The first prize consists of a certificate and is endowed with 1,500 euros. The second and third prizes also come with a certificate and a cash prize of 1,000 euros and 500 euros respectively.

Please note: Only one candidate (f/m/d) from a university or institute etc. can be admitted. If there are several applications from a research or university institution, the program committee will ask the head (f/m/d) of your institution for an internal decision.

Please note the following requirements for an application:

The following data is required to register for the competition:

- your full name and contact details
- your lecture topic;
- the name of the institution where the presentation was prepared
- the date of submission and defense/examination of your thesis

Please submit a short abstract of your work in English with a maximum of 1,500 characters and a maximum of 6 authors.

Your short abstract, all presentation slides and the presentation itself must be in English. Unless otherwise decided by the program committee, the duration of the presentation is 12 minutes, followed by 3 minutes for discussion.
